**RESOLUTION**

Expressing support for July to be designated as “Disability  
Pride Month”.

Whereas according to the Centers for Disease Control and  
Prevention 61,000,000 American adults have a disability  
that impacts major life activities;

Whereas the United States Census Bureau reports that over  
3,000,000 children have disabilities;

Whereas the Americans with Disabilities Act (42 U.S.C.  
12101 et seq.) was signed into law on July 26, 1990;

Whereas people with a disability remain at an increased risk  
of experiencing discrimination, isolation, and inequities;

Whereas people with disabilities are vital, and make meaning-  
ful contributions in the American arts, science,

healthcare, technology, sports, education, law, and many more sectors; and

Whereas “Disability Pride Month” is celebrated in July by Americans across the country: Now, therefore, be it

1       *Resolved*, That the House of Representatives—

2               (1) expresses the support for July to be des-  
3       ignated as “Disability Pride Month”; and

4               (2) calls on the people of the United States, in-  
5       terest groups, and affected people to—

6               (A) to observe Disability Pride Month with  
7       appropriate celebrations and activities; and

8               (B) take an active role in the prevention of  
9       exclusion of and discrimination against people  
10      with disabilities.
