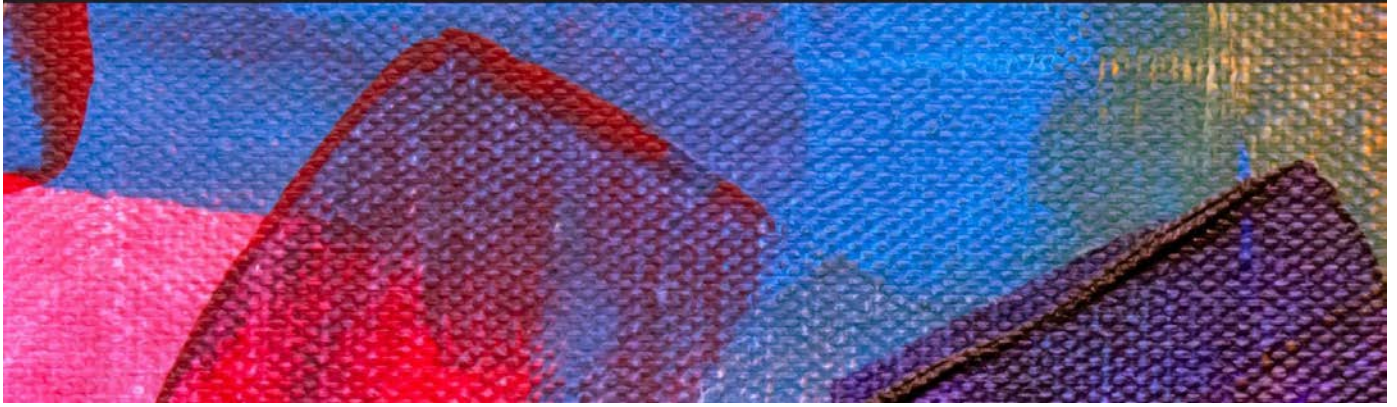

DIGITAL SUBMISSION INSTRUCTIONS

Only digital submissions will be accepted for judging this year.

- Digital images should clearly show the entire work of art.
- Images must be submitted as a JPEG document. The image should contain 72 pixels per inch, be 10 inches on the longest side and be no larger than 1.8 MB.
- Each image must be labeled with the student's first initial, last name and school name (example: [j_smith_highlandpark.jpg](#))
- Please keep images free of identifying information (artist name, etc.) as this will require cropping of the image.
- Please e-mail your entry to MN04Arts@mail.house.gov
- Student Release Forms must be attached to your e-mail as a separate document.

Deadline for Entries is Friday, April 24, 2020, no later than 4:30pm
